Thank you for buying my book! I first came up with the idea of arranging 50 carols and songs into medleys when I was playing Christmas Eve services a few years ago. I tied a few pieces together with interludes and thought, wouldn't it be nice to have just one book with each of the carols flowing into the next? The melodies fit so beautifully together and can be played individually as well as in medleys.

This book is for the beginner to advanced beginner harpist. It is written for the fully-levered harp with at least 25 strings. Your harp needs to be tuned in E Flat Major. (With all the levers down, tune the B, E, and A strings to flat). I wrote the levers you need to raise at the beginning of each new key. Whenever possible I kept the carols and songs in their original keys.

Since there is often more than one song on each page, it can be helpful to highlight the repeat signs. To vary the music, try playing an octave higher on the repeats. Slower carols can be played freely and expressively. Whether performing for an audience or at home, I hope you enjoy playing this beautiful collection of music as much as l've enjoyed arranging it.
