### Screwdriver Dances

(for 2 or 3\* harps)

These pieces may be played individually or as a set.

#### Raindrop Waltz

Screwdriver Glissando:

Pull the screwdriver against the indicated string, pluck, and slide the screwdriver gently up or down to a specific pitch.

### **Dragonfly Minuet**

Screwdriver Tremolo:

Wiggle the screwdriver quickly between two adjacent strings (without plucking).

## Spring Polka

Screwdriver Vibrato:

Pull the screwdriver against the string, pluck, and wiggle the screwdriver quickly up and down.

<sup>\*</sup>The optional 3<sup>rd</sup> harp does not have printed music and only plays the screwdriver parts. It may be taught by rote and played by ear, following the other two harps.

# Raindrop Waltz (for 2 or 3 harps)

Screwdriver glissandi:

Harp 1: LH plays 4th octave E while RH pulls the screwdriver against the same string. Use a pen to mark the spots on the string which sould like C and G.

Pluck as you hold the screwdriver on the top dot, then gently slide to the bottom dot. Reverse direction for the next measure.

Harp 2: LH plays 4th octave B while RH pulls the screwdriver against the same string. Use a pen to mark the spots on the string which sound like F and C.

Pluck as you hold the screwdriver on the top dot, then gently slide to the bottom dot.

Reverse direction for the next measure.

Harp 3 (optional): mark both the 4th octave B and E strings.

Play only the screwdriver glissandi for the whole piece.
